Dear Crafters, Exhibitors and Vendors:

You are cordially invited to participate at the 3rd Appomattox RiverFest hosted by the Friends of the Lower Appomattox River (FOLAR). We are looking forward to another very successful event! We plan to publicize the RiverFest in local newspapers, radio and television, online and through social media and to the **Fort Lee community** reaching thousands in the region.

If you wish to sell food or goods, this information is for you.

- The Festival is a RAIN OR SHINE event.
- Booth spaces are approximately 10 X 10 feet.
- All crafters-vendors must supply their own tables, chairs and tent canopies (if desired).
- Electricity will only be available in a few areas. These spaces will fill quickly on a first come basis. You will need to supply your own extension cords.
- **All booths and activities will be located outdoors in the park setting on earthen ground.** There are a few picnic table pavilions on cement slabs available first-come-first serve.
- Booth assignments and arrival/set-up instructions will be emailed on or before April 15, 2017. PLEASE NOTE: We will be assigning arrival/set-up times based on your booth location. Make sure to include an email address with your application.
- Break down and/or driving in the festival/crafter area is not allowed prior to 3:00 pm due to safety issues.
- Suggested donation to participate: \$30

The deadline for submitting your application for booth space is April 3, 2017. Due to the success of past year's RiverFest and the regional appeal of the Festival, we expect spaces to fill quickly. All assignments are on a first-come first-served basis.

Event Participation RULES

Place: Appomattox Riverside-Ferndale Park in Petersburg
Date: Saturday, April 29, 2017, RAIN OR SHINE 10AM – 3PM
(Booths must be set up and vehicles moved to lot by 9:30am)

1. Exhibitor's spaces are not to be shared with nor sublet to a third party without written approval from the Friends of the Lower Appomattox River (FOLAR).
2. Each exhibitor shall maintain his/her items only within its leased space and keep that space in a neat and clean condition. All trash must be removed by exhibitors at the end of the Festival.
3. Each exhibitor shall have his/her car unloaded and moved from the unloading area by 9:30 am. Arrival/unloading times will be assigned based on booth location. The driveway will be closed at this time.
4. Each exhibitor shall have his/her own booth set up by 9:30 am and no booths are to be shut down until 3:00 pm unless, in the discretion of the organizer, exhibitors are directed to do so, pursuant to these rules and regulations.
5. The organizer reserves the right to terminate the agreement of any space to an exhibitor whose actions or goods offered for sale are in violation of the rules, regulations, theme, standards or purpose of the Lower Appomattox RiverFest. The exhibitor also agrees to remove any item(s) which, in the opinion of the organizer, is not in good taste, duplicates one of the Festival booths or does not meet the standard of the organizer.
6. As we must put the safety of the public attending the event as our foremost priority, the crafters/patrons/community booths etc. will not be able to drive vehicles into the festival area or into crafter row until after 3:00.

RiverFest organizers reserve the right to change these rules at any time.
